



MARIPOSA YOSEMITE ROTARY CLUB GO WEST OUTHOUSE DERBY RULES AND REGULATIONS



OFFICIAL OUTHOUSE SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Minimum Outhouse Weight: 200 pounds, without driver.
2. Minimum Height: 6 feet from the ground to the highest point on the main body, does not include chimneys, flags, signs, etc.
3. Minimum Floor Size: 9 square feet
4. Outhouse must be completely enclosed with an operating door, curtain closure OK.
5. Outhouse must contain a toilet seat and roll of toilet paper.
6. Outhouses may have any number or type of wheels propelling the outhouse
7. Brakes are optional
8. Outhouses may be built of any material.
9. Outhouses may not have a motor or pedals and must be pushed by hand by two crew members. Pushers must be in contact with the outhouse at all times.
10. Outhouses may have a logo, company or personal names painted on sides, top, or on inside, but NOT required.
11. Each outhouse should have a catchy name but entrants are cautioned about the language they use on their outhouses.
12. The decisions of the Judges at the starting line, the judges at the finish line, and the race organizers are *FINAL*.

CREW

1. A crew shall consist of three members: two pushers, a driver/rider.
Two alternates are allowed. All crew members must be of basic humanoid ancestry.
2. All crew must be over 16.
3. Pushers may only push for one team.
4. No dogs or other animals that cannot make a reasonable choice may ride in the outhouse.
5. Each crew member must sign a liability waiver.

ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES

1. Entry fee is \$50 for each race entry. Make checks out to: **Mariposa Yosemite Rotary Club**

AWARDS

Awards will be given for 1st through 3rd place.

The awards ceremony will be held after the last race and the tallies are finished.

FORMAT

Two outhouses race at a time in an elimination format. Races begin every fifteen minutes beginning at 10:00 until all outhouses have raced.

RACE RULES

1. All outhouses and crew must be checked in by 8:30am on October 14, 2017
2. Outhouse racing teams will consist of 1 driver / rider and 2 pushers.
3. Outhouses must be pushed or pulled by human power only.
4. Outhouses must be kept in designated area while not racing
5. At starting line no portion of outhouse may extend over the line. It will be judge's determination as to a restart.
6. Outhouse teams must maintain control of their outhouse at all times during the race.
7. Outhouses must remain in their designated lane during the entire race.
If an outhouse crosses into a competitor's lane and, in the opinion of the judges, interferes with that outhouse's ability to race, the offending outhouse will be disqualified for that heat.
8. The first outhouse to reach the finish line WINS! Close finished to be determined by the judges. In case of a tie or photo finish, the race will be re-run.
